Early Education Teacher - Bachelor's degree

Career: The lead teacher is responsible for the supervision, safety and education of the students.

Teacher Assistant - High school diploma and completion of one 3-credit college course in early childhood education

Career: The Teacher Assistant supports a classroom under the supervision of the Head Teacher or Teacher Associate in implementing quality early childhood programs.

Program Administrator/Director - Bachelor's degree or higher

Career: The Program Administrator is responsible for the overall leadership of the early childhood program including: overseeing the administrative functions, the educational quality and regulatory compliance.
