In 2021

WE LAID THE FOUNDATION

In 2021, we worked with our partners and legislative champions to help pass H.171 (the child care bill), that lays the foundation for our future child care system by:

- Establishing state goals for child care affordability, access, and quality, prioritizing stakeholder input and engaging experts to identify long-term funding sources to guide our continued work together.
- Investing \$12.7 million to stabilize Vermont's child care system by supporting family affordability, Vermont's early childhood education workforce, and infrastructure improvement, and studying our current child care system to inform future transformation.
