Steps and Tips for Taking Quality Photos and for Posting on Social Media

Here are a few tips for taking quality photos when you're out and about supporting Let's Grow Kids in your community:

- 1.) If you're wearing LGK swag, make sure it's visible!
- 2.) If you're with a political candidate, make sure they get in the photo!
- 3.) Check your lighting use the sun to your advantage but don't let it wash out your photo.
- 4.) Horizontal photos work better on social media.
- 5.) It's better to get closer and not use too much zoom.

Then submit your photos to Let's Grow Kids! You can send photos directly to info@letsgrowkids.org with the subject line "LGK Photos" and please make sure to include your name, where you're from and/or where the photo was taken.

Here are a few tips for posting on social media:

Step 1: If you haven't already, make sure to follow and like @LetGrowKids on <u>Facebook</u>, <u>Instagram</u>, and <u>Twitter!</u>

Step 2: When posting pictures from an event—make sure to TAG Let's Grow Kids in those posts. If you're new to tagging, just type @Let'sGrowKids—a menu will drop down, and you can just click on the LGK logo.

Step 3: Use hashtags! You can hashtag the town or city where the photos were taken (e.g. #Waterbury) and if it's for a holiday or theme, make sure to include that, like #July4th.

*Remember to keep your posts positive and to the point. Shorter posts typically get more engagement on social media.
