







Surveillance Month

Recommendations!

- Flu shot for everyone over 6 months (it's not too late!)
- RSV vaccine for pregnant people between 32-36 weeks gestation (available through end of Jan) – pharmacies have most reliable supply
- Infants less than 8 months RSV shot (nirsevimab/beyfortus) – supply is limited but available at some clinics
